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ART. 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

ART. 1.1 OBJECTIVES

Erasmus+ individual learning mobility is regulated by the Erasmus+ programme 2021/2027. (EU Regulation no.2021/817 of the European Parliament and of the Council of May 20, 2021 and the Erasmus+ Programme Guide 2021/2027). Through lifelong learning, the Programme promotes educational, professional and personal development of students and promotes sustainable growth, employment, innovation, social cohesion, the strengthening of the European identity and active citizenship.

The Erasmus+ programme also allows participation in non-EU countries, known as Partner Countries. The European countries traditionally included in the Erasmus+ programme are referred to as the Programme Countries.

Erasmus students receive a grant and have the right to:

- attend courses and use the available structures at the hosting institution without further tuition fees (in some cases small contributions might be requested as for local students);
- combine a period of study with a period of traineeship or research for the preparation of the thesis;
- carry out research under the PhD or Specialisation School;

All activities conducted abroad (with a positive outcome) will be fully recognized in the student's career **as long as they were previously approved by the Learning Agreement/Change Form**. Full recognition of activities carried out abroad is one of the commitments undertaken by Sapienza University of Rome with the approval of the Erasmus Policy Statement (EPS) and the "[Regulation for Student Mobility and Recognition of Study and Training Periods Abroad](#)".

ART. 1.2 MOBILITY TOWARDS CIVIS ALLIANCE UNIVERSITIES

Sapienza is a partner of the "CIVIS - A European Civic University" Alliance financed by the European Union. The alliance has been active since October 1, 2019 and includes the following universities:

ART.1.3 PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

It will be possible to participate in the Erasmus+ programme by study at the universities with which Sapienza has signed an interinstitutional agreement, included in one of the following country groups:



- **Programme Countries** that include: Member States of the European Union, the Countries of the European Economic Area (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway) and the Countries applying for accession to the EU (Turkey, Serbia and the Republic of North Macedonia);
- **Partner Countries:** United Kingdom and Switzerland.

ART. 2 REQUIREMENTS

ART. 2.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. In order to apply to this call students must be enrolled (including part-time students) at Sapienza for **Academic Year 2021/22** in a Bachelor's, Master's, Single-cycle or PhD degree programmes, or Specialisation Schools.
2. In case of Specialisation Programmes, the payment of the Erasmus grant is subject to the compatibility of the specialisation contract with Erasmus grants. Incompatibility still allows participation in the programme, but students will not receive any grant for the mobility period.
3. Students must have **adequate language skills** (see Art. 2.4 "LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS").
4. Students must **complete their enrolment at Sapienza University for Academic Year 2022/2023 by the established deadlines** (further information: <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina-strutturale/studenti> "University Tuition"), except for graduating students, under Art. 13 of the "Student Regulations". Hence, students who plan to graduate in the extraordinary session Academic Year 2021/2022 do not have to enrol for the A.Y. 2022/2023, but the mobility must be concluded before graduation. In case of missed graduation within the extraordinary session A.Y. 2021/2022, enrolment for the Academic Year 2022/2023 would be required.
5. Students enrolled in the third (or subsequent) year of a Bachelor's Programme (First cycle) in Academic Year 2021/2022, and who expect to graduate by the end of the academic year, may apply for a mobility period for the first year of a Master's Degree (Second cycle). However, the mobility period **must take place in the second semester** of Academic Year 2022/2023. If such students apply for mobility periods longer than a semester, the period will be automatically reduced. Before leaving, students selected under these conditions must be enrolled in a Master's Programme for Academic Year 2022/2023. **Moreover, these students may not, under any circumstance, enjoy their mobility period during the first semester.**
6. **Graduating students on Erasmus mobility are allowed to graduate only after the end of their study period abroad and once the online recognition procedure for the educational activity scheduled in the Learning Agreement/ Change Form (exams or thesis research) is completed. If the above requirements are not complied, students have to refund the grant (Article 9 Learning Agreement).**
7. **PhD Students** must complete their mobility period before the official end of the Doctoral Programme and obtain a Declaration concerning the activity carried out from the host university.
8. **Specialisation students** must be **authorised** by the Director of their Specialisation School to benefit from a mobility period and also obtain a Declaration concerning the activity carried out from the host university.

ART. 2.2 INCOMPATIBILITY

Students applying to this call may benefit from one or more Erasmus+ mobility grants (Bachelor's, Master's, PhDs) provided **the total period does not exceed 12 months per each cycle**. For Single-cycle degrees **the maximum period is 24 months**.

Any Erasmus mobility carried out in **virtual mode from the country of residence**, will not be counted in the computing of the maximum Erasmus mobility months for each cycle.



Each candidate is responsible for verifying the residual number of Erasmus mobility months for the cycle they are enrolled in and asking for a possible reduction of the mobility period if not compatible. Otherwise the mobility **could be cancelled and the grants already paid must be returned**.

Please note: as per Art. 76 - D.P.R. 28.12.2000 N. 445 "... **whoever provides false declarations, false acts or uses them for the purposes of the present call is liable for punishment as established by legislation and all special bills in this matter.**"

Prior mobility periods that have already been funded during the same study cycle under: ICM (International Credit Mobility), Lifelong Learning Programme, Erasmus+, Erasmus Mundus Action 1 and Erasmus Mundus Action 2 **are included in the calculation of the total number of months spent abroad.**

ART. 2.3 ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

1. Academic requirements to apply for the call:

CLM students Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthesis

- Students enrolled in the first year of the course CANNOT apply.
- Be enrolled in the second year and have acquired a number of CFU not less than 1/5 of those that can be acquired up to the expiry date of the call.
- Be enrolled in the third year or later and have acquired all the credits of the first year of the course (all the exams of the first year).

CLM students Biomedical Scientific Communication (Comunicazione Scientifica Biomedica)

- All students who have acquired a number of CFU not less than 1/5 of all those that can be acquired at the deadline date can apply

CdS/CLM students Sciences, cultures and gastronomic politics for wellbeing (Scienze, culture e politiche gastronomiche per il benessere)

- All students who have acquired a number of CFU not less than 1/5 of all those that can be acquired at the deadline date can apply

CdS / CLM students Health professions

- All students who have acquired a number of CFU not less than 1/5 of all those that can be acquired at the deadline date can apply.

Specialization schools / doctorates

To be enrolled in one of the following Specialization Schools / doctorates:

- School of Specialization in Dermatology and venereology
- Doctorate in Clinical Experimental Neuroscience and Psychiatry
- Doctorate in Innovative technologies in diseases of skeleton, skin and oro-cranio-facial district (Tecnologie innovative nelle malattie dello scheletro, della cute e del distretto oro-cranio facciale).

All credits acquired until the application submission, obtained exclusively through exams and **officially registered on Infostud**, will be accepted for the selection process. Students may self-certify exams they have taken, but that have not yet been registered on Infostud, on their application.

ART. 2.4 LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS



Students applying to the Call must have a **minimum A2 language level** Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) recognised by the European Council <https://www.coe.int/en/web/common-european-framework-reference-languages>

Candidates must demonstrate their linguistic competence through:

1. a passed test in November 2021, January or February 2022 sessions at the CLA (Sapienza Language Centre), before sending the online application;
2. a passed CLA test for the previous call (Bando Erasmus+ 2021/2022). Students who do not want to use this exemption, may retake the CLA test. In this case, the new result (higher, lower or failed score for the language test repeated) will replace the previous one;
3. the satisfaction of the requirements described in Article 2.4.3 “**LANGUAGE TEST EXEMPTIONS**”.

Tests or other exemption certificates must be obtained before sending the online application.

PLEASE NOTE: the CLA test does not exempt students from verifying and complying with the language requirements of the host university, which must be respected to benefit from the selected mobility.

ART. 2.4.1 LANGUAGE TESTS

The tests – **only for FRENCH, ENGLISH, PORTUGUESE, SPANISH, GERMAN** – will be held in presence at CLA and students must attend the test with a valid ID (identity card, passport or driving licence).

Students who had not already taken the test in the sessions of November 2021 or January 2022, must book the time and date for the test among the available options **listed in the application form**, according to the following schedule:

- from February 14 to February 18, 2022, with two shifts at 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM;
- from February 21 to February 22, 2022, with two shifts at 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM.

PLEASE NOTE: only available dates and shifts will be displayed on the application form.

Test registration is valid only if you receive a confirmation e-mail on your university account.

Students can take tests for a maximum of two languages based on the selected destinations, mandatorily on the same day and shift/time. Only one test can be taken for each language.

The language tests are multistage (students can progress to the next level only if they reach the minimum score) with:

- multiple choice questions;
- cloze questions;
- drag and drop texts.

Tests are mainly focused on grammar knowledge and text comprehension **with no speaking and listening**.

The level starts at A2 and progresses step by step, based on your score, up to level C1. Maximum amount of time permitted is 60 minutes (if you complete all four levels).

Online mock tests are not available.

PLEASE NOTE: there will be no recovery sessions.

Students who have already taken the test in November 2021 or January 2022 cannot retake the test for the same languages.

There will be a maximum of 340 available places per day (170 students per shift) and each shift may be booked as long as places are available.



We recommend you to book your tests as soon as possible to have the widest possible choice in the available dates.

The results of February 2022 session will be published on Moodle, but they will be imported on the application only if students open the form at the following link:

The results will be displayed in the application by 25.02.2022.

Students who have already taken the CLA test in November 2021 and January 2022 are invited to log in their application form to allow the import of the test score by **February 15, 2022**.

The attestation of the score obtained **at the language test will be issued only to students who are assignee of an Erasmus mobility**. This attestation is NOT a legal language certificate and it can be downloaded directly from the Erasmus personal page.

ART. 2.4.2 INFORMATION FOR DISABLED STUDENTS AND SERVICES FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING DISORDERS.

Students with disabilities (as per Art. 3 of Bill N. 104/1992) and/or disabilities equal or greater to 66% are exempt from the computer-delivered language test. They must indicate this on the language test booking form. The CLA will test student language knowledge on the basis of suitable procedures.

Students with learning disorders (as per Bill N. 170/2010 and DM N. 5669/2011) who require specific aid to complete the test, must indicate this on their language test booking form. Candidates with learning disorders will be given 30% additional time.

Particular situations will be examined on the basis of the provided certifications.

All requests must be submitted by the language test registration deadline (see Art.2.4.1. "LANGUAGE TESTS") and will be verified by the Office for Students with Disabilities and Specific Learning Difficulties, which may request official certifications from the National Health Service or accredited specialists and facilities.

Learning disorder certification must refer to official reading/writing/calculation levels. Diagnosis must be updated after 3 years, if it was issued to a minor.

PLEASE NOTE: students with disabilities or learning disorders, who are resident abroad and intend to enjoy the measures described above, must submit certifications issued in their country of residence together with a sworn translation into Italian or English.

ART. 2.4.3 EXEMPTION FROM LANGUAGE TESTS

Students with the following requisites are exempted from the CLA language test, but must still observe minimum requisites required by the host university:

- 1) Students who have passed the language test held at CLA for application to the Erasmus+ call for A.Y. 2021-22, under conditions set in Article 2.4.
- 2) Mother tongue – for the language selected for the mobility; as indicated by the Ministry of Public Education with Circular N. 5494 - 29/12/1982 (ref: C.U.N. 30/10/1982), the quality of a foreign mother tongue speaker is recognised for "Italian and foreign citizens only when it is proven that they have completed at least all of their elementary and secondary education in the country where



that language is spoken, either at public or (recognized) private schools of the same nationality.” Mother tongue language level corresponds to level C2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

- 3) You have an official **certificate for level A2** issued by an agency recognized by CEFR (see Annex 1) for the language/s selected for mobility.
- 4) Enrolment in a Sapienza degree programme that is held entirely in English, only in case the student applies for a destination that requires English for mobility purposes.
- 5) High School Diploma from an international lyceum recognised by MUR for English, French (ESABAC diploma), German, Spanish or Portuguese. (A High School Diploma at an international high school corresponds to level B2).
- 6) Level A2 language skills acquired during a mobility period in academic year 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 for at least one of the languages indicated in Art. 2.4.1 “LANGUAGE TESTS” issued by the Language Centre at the host university.
- 7) Bilingual when the second language is the same one selected for the mobility (bilingual status is acknowledged to students who have completed at least the primary, secondary and high school cycles in the Special Administrative Regions or in the Autonomous Provinces in which bilingualism exists according to the regional law). Students who want to make use of this exemption need to provide a self-declaration in accordance with D.P.R. 445/2000.

PLEASE NOTE:

- If students intend to apply for a **host university that requires a higher level** than the one required in the cases above, or where a different language is required, they **will have to take the CLA test**.
- Students **enrolled in an English course** will be exempted from taking the test only if the language level needed in their degree programme is the same (or higher) of the one requested by the host university.

Language tests taken as part of a degree programme do NOT exempt you from the CLA Test. Similarly, declarations issued by professors, even university professors, and language exams will not be considered valid.

ART. 2.5 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

This Call is open to:

1. students enrolled exclusively in the Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine (medical area) and Medicine and Dentistry.
2. Students enrolled in one of the school of specialisation on or in a doctorate course indicated in the ART. 2.3 Academic requirements. Students enrolled in a research doctorate or in a Specialisation Schools require clearance from the Coordinator of the Doctorate or from the Director of the Specialization school
3. Students who intend to conduct research activities for their dissertation must indicate the subject of their research work and obtain approval from their Italian Thesis Supervisor and indicate the name of their foreign supervisor and obtain the credits before the degree.

ART. 3 DURATION

The length of the mobility is defined by the inter-institutional agreement signed between Sapienza and the partner universities.

The mobility can be started from **June 1, 2022**, to be concluded by **September 30, 2023** and should be performed **continuously**. **The duration could be reduced compared to the call-in case the semester period does not coincide with the academic calendar of the foreign university.**

There are two types of mobility:



1. Erasmus **LONG MOBILITY** for I, II and III study cycle:

It can be carried out by all those belonging to the I, II and III cycle at the partner universities (Programme Countries and Partner Countries, see Art. 1.3 Participating Countries). Each *long mobility* must have a **minimum duration of 2 months (60 days)** and maximum 12 or 24 months (in case of single cycle).

The duration could change only for well-proved academic reasons in which the students:

- Start the mobility in the second semester,
- Have already benefited from mobility periods in the same cycle (Art. 2.2). In this case the maximum length will be reduced to the residual months according to the limit of 12 per cycle and 24 months for single cycle, subject to prior approval of the partner university.

2. Erasmus **SHORT MOBILITY** only for PhD students:

The *short mobility* can be carried out only by students enrolled in a PhD Programme. It must have a **minimum duration of 5 days and maximum 30 days** and it should be performed only in Programme Countries.

The short mobility must always be previously authorised by the host university (see Art. 7.3 APPLICATION "SHORT MOBILITY" FOR PhD STUDENTS).

ART. 4 GRANTS

The determination of grants will be subject to the approval of the agreement with the National Agency Erasmus+ Indire and the University Board of Governors.

Mobility grants **are assigned exclusively for academic activities at the partner university** (see art. 6 "ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES ABROAD"). In order to receive Erasmus grants, the mobility student must accept the terms of the financial contract before departure and follow the instructions that will be provided at the time of the assignment of the mobility.

ART. 4.1. EU GRANTS

Grants must be considered as a contribution to the expenses related to their stay abroad.

Erasmus EU grants are incompatible with grants from other programmes/actions funded by the European Union.

The amount of grants varies according to:

1. Type of mobility (*Long mobility* o *Short mobility* for PhD students);
2. Destination Country.

The EU Grants for "**LONG MOBILITY**", is related to living cost of destination country and to the days of attendance certified by the partner Universities:

GROUP 1 HIGHER living cost: Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden.	350,00 euro
GROUP 2 MEDIUM living cost: Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Germany, Greece, Malta, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain.	300,00 euro
GROUP 3 LOWER living cost: Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Turkey, Hungary.	250,00 euro

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PLEASE NOTE:

Mobility to Switzerland, **if directly financed by the Swiss Government, will not receive the EU Grant**

EU Grant reserved to “**SHORT MOBILITY**” (limited to Programme Countries), **only for PhD students** will be paid on the basis of a daily amount

Duration	Daily amount
“ SHORT MOBILITY ” for a period between 5 and 14 days	70 euro
“ SHORT MOBILITY ” for a period between 15 and 30 days	50 euro

In case EU funds are depleted, and/or students receive other university or EU grants, students may receive an “Erasmus-Zero-EU-Grant” status that will allow them to enjoy the benefits of the mobility period, but without receiving an EU grant.

ART. 4.2 ADDITIONAL MUR AND SAPIENZA GRANT FOR STUDENTS WITH DISADVANTAGED BACKGROUNDS

In addition to the EU grant, mobility students will receive additional funding from Sapienza and the Ministry of University and Research (MUR).

The MUR grant allocation will be paid **according to the economic conditions of students** who are obliged to prove it through ISEE/ISEE PARIFICATO 2022 (ISEE for right to university study DPCM 159/2013).

The data must be available on Infostud by November 30, 2022 or before the acceptance of the terms of the Financial Agreement. Otherwise the MUR grant cannot be allocated.

IMPORTANT:

- All students and/or PhD students, Specialisation School students **who are exempted from submitting the ISEE** for the payment of fees, **in order to benefit from the MUR Grant, will still have to apply for the ISEE 2022 (ISEE for right to university study);**
- The Sapienza and the MUR grants **will not be paid to irregular students** (beyond the allotted time to attain a degree) from the second year onwards (calculation will take the initial enrolment year at Sapienza into account, also in case of transfer to another degree programme).



Students who do not obtain, by December 31,2023, the online recognition of at least **6 CFUs** (reduced to **3 CFUs** for students who perform exclusively research activities for the preparation of the thesis), will be required to refund the total grant. Credit recognition must be completed exclusively through the digitised procedures on the Erasmus personal page, which provides for validation by the Academic Coordinator for International Mobility (RAM, Article 9).

The above limits do not apply to **PhD students and Specialisation School students**.

ART. 4.3 ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR DISABLED STUDENTS AND/OR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

1. In order to allow a wider student participation in the mobility programme, **Indire - the National Agency for Erasmus+ allocates grants intended to support disabled students and/or students with special needs**.
2. Students must communicate their disability/special need both through their **application form and upon acceptance**, if assigned a mobility period.
3. The above-mentioned selected students will receive information about the application as soon as Indire – the National Agency for Erasmus+ provides details; the relevant note will be published on the webpage <http://www.uniroma1.it/erasmus/studenti-students/erasmus-studenti-diversamente-abili>.
4. The financing of the Grant for special needs will be subject to the allocation of funds from the National Agency Erasmus Plus INDIRE. If financial coverage is not available in full or in part, students will have to bear the costs themselves.

ART. 4.4 TAXATION OF THE ERASMUS + GRANT

Under Article 1, paragraph 50, Law No 208 - 28.12.2015, grants for international mobility are subject to the exemptions provided by Article 1, paragraph 3, Decree-Law N. 105 - 9 May 2003, converted with amendments into Law N. 170 - 11 July 2003, except further amendments.

ART. 5 AVAILABLE DESTINATIONS AND PLACES

1. Students may apply to 1 up to 5 destinations.
2. **The priority order indicated on your application is binding for the assignment of destinations**, if the candidate is eligible for more than one destination. **Please make sure you have the necessary language level that will allow you to attend lessons and take exams at the chosen destination** (See Art. 2.4 “LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS”).

PLEASE NOTE: In selecting possible destinations, students must keep in mind that only two language tests are allowed, in addition to any applicable exemptions (see Art. 2.4.3 “EXEMPTION FROM LANGUAGE TESTS”)

3. The following **table** lists the number of available places, mobility period and requisites to apply for:

- Destination with Erasmus+ mobility agreements as part of the CIVIS Alliance (Art. 1.5);

PLEASE NOTE: Available places and destinations listed in the call are subject to modification if the partner universities or national and European organisations regulating the programme introduce variations. Before applying, please independently verify the feasibility of studying at your preferred destinations on the websites of the individual universities.



Moreover, at the time of the publication of the call the agreements are still not officially signed because, as required by the new programme Erasmus+ 2021-2027, agreements should be approved digitally through Erasmus Without Papers, still to be implemented in all Programme Countries. Consequently, some conditions might change during the signing phase and not all the selected students might actually take part in the mobility and/or participate under the same conditions listed in this call. The impact of this transitional phase on student selection will be limited as far as possible. However, it is important that candidates are aware that the availability of all the places published in the call is under condition.

3. It will not be possible to guarantee the start of a mobility period in the 1st semester for destinations that have a deadline (for the submission of the student nomination) that is not compatible with the publication of the final ranking (Art. 14 “END OF PROCEDURE”).

When choosing mobility, please pay attention to the language level required for attendance at the host university. The requirements in the table have been indicated by the individual partner universities. Interested students are however invited to personally investigate the actual correspondence of these requirements with respect to the requested locations.

ATTENTION: Even if the locations do not require a mandatory certificate, a minimum level of linguistic competence provided by the host University is still required, equal to level A2 (as per art. 2.4 Language requirements).

ART. 6 ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES ABROAD

Students must **NOT indicate the didactic activities** they intend to pursue abroad **in the Application Form** but it is mandatory to consult the didactic offer of the venues on foreign sites, in order to avoid refunds of contributions due to didactic incompatibilities.

In addition, they have to consider the coherence between the subject area of the host university and their own course of study. In case of applications submitted in the transition period between a Bachelor's (I cycle) and a Master's Degree (II cycle), students should consider the academic activities scheduled for the Master's Study Plan.

The didactic activities must be integrated upon completion of the official study plan (Art. 9 “LEARNING AGREEMENT”) that will have to be approved by the Degree Programme Academic Coordinator for International Mobility (RAM).

Admissible mobility activities are:

- Attendance of courses and exams;
- Research for graduation and/or doctoral thesis;
- Curricular traineeship (only if relevant to the didactic plan)

After having consulted the course catalogue of the foreign university, students should contact the Agreement Promoter (Art. 4. AVAILABLE DESTINATIONS AND PLACES) for didactic information.

PhD students and candidates enrolled in Specialisation Schools, after having verified their eligibility for a mobility period abroad, must agree on the educational programme abroad with the Coordinator of their PhD Programme/Specialisation School. Moreover, they will have to ascertain their insurance coverage with the relevant offices.

ART. 7 APPLICATION

ART. 7.1 DEADLINES AND SUBMISSION

1. The deadline for submission of the on-line application form is *March 4, 2022*. at 2.00 pm (Italian time).

3. In order to apply, **you must use your university email account** (familyname.studentnumber@studenti.uniroma1.it).

This will be the only official means used for communications related to this call and the subsequent procedures.

Once the application has been completed, candidates will receive a report of all the data submitted at their university email address **as the only valid receipt for their application**. Thus, all applicants must verify that they receive this report and that all the data submitted is correct. Any errors must be immediately reported to the Faculty Erasmus Administrative Officer:

ART. 7.2 DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT

PLEASE NOTE: If mandatory documents are not uploaded by the deadline, or the declared/self-certified information is not correct, the application will be rejected.

ART. 7.3 SHORT MOBILITY APPLICATION FOR PhD STUDENTS

PhD students who wish to apply for an Erasmus+ “SHORT MOBILITY” are required to declare it when applying by flagging the proper field next to the selected university. If students do not declare their willingness to carry out a short mobility in their application, the mobility will be considered as a “LONG MOBILITY” and will have to comply with the related requirements (Article 3 DURATION).

ART. 8 RANKING

ART. 8.1 RANKING PROCESS

- A Commission composed by the CAM of both Faculties and by the administrative responsables (RAEF) of both Faculties will evaluate all applications.
- Two rankings will be produced: **one for CIVIS Universities and one for other Erasmus+ destinations**.
- The selection process will be based on your academic transcript. Evaluation criteria will be finalised by the Commission during its first meeting and will be defined coherently with the evaluation requirements.
- The ranking will not take into account the certificates of linguistic competence, which will be used



only for the assignment of the locations/places, in consideration of the correspondence of the linguistic requirement indicated by the partner University.

- Students are required to present the certificates attesting their knowledge of the language (which must be among those recognized and listed in Annex 1) together with the Erasmus application form. Language certificates will NOT be accepted after the Erasmus application deadline.

FIRST EVALUATION CRITERIA

Number of exams taken at the time of application until the year of the course in which you enrolled, excluding eligibility*. For students enrolled in the Specialist Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery it is mandatory to indicate the Degree Course (A-B-C-D-E-F).

There is an obligation to declare in the order form as specified in the ART.6.2, the year of first enrollment in the degree course in which you enrolled at the time of application, which will be used to calculate the actual years of enrollment.

For those who come from other faculties and other degree courses, it is mandatory to declare the academic year of enrollment in the degree course in which you enrolled at the time of the Erasmus application.

SECOND EVALUATION CRITERIA

Precise arithmetic average (with two decimal places) **of the exams passed**, considering that 30/30 with honors is worth 31.

SCORES ASSIGNED TO THE CRITERIA REQUIRED BY THE CALL

The maximum score achievable by the student is 10, divided as follows:

- ✓ first criteria - maximum score 5
- ✓ second criteria - maximum score 5

***First criteria - PERCENTAGE OF TESTS TAKEN**

The number of exams the student has taken is divided by the number of exams the student could have taken. The fraction is multiplied by the coefficient 5. Suitability is not taken into account.

Second criteria- AVERAGE VOTES

The average is calculated, paying attention to the fact that the value corresponding to 30 cum laude is 31. With reference to this requirement, the overall score is calculated using the following formula: $5 \times (\text{grade point average}) / 31$

PLEASE NOTE: the following do not concur to the calculation of your GPA and CFUs:

- Exams taken abroad during Erasmus periods that have not yet been validated through the online recognition procedure;
- Extracurricular exams (former Art. 6 - Regio Decreto N. 1269/38) as they do not count for CFUs necessary to graduate;
- Integrated exams and elective educational activities (ADE) if the credits related to all the modules of each integrated exam have not been completed yet;
- Exams for single courses that have not been recognised as part of the degree programme (Bachelor's, Master's, Single Cycle) where the student is currently enrolled;
- Exams cancelled due to lack of prerequisites;
- Exams declared as taken, which instead are only or not even booked.



In assigning mobility periods, **in case of identical scores**, priority will be given to students who have never benefited from an Erasmus mobility for study and placement/traineeship.

In case of further equality, priority will be given to the student enrolled in the year of the course closest to the degree and in the case of further equal merit, to the oldest in age.

For Postgraduates/PhD students will be used the following criteria:

- Year of enrollment, with priority for those closest to the end of the specialization / doctorate
- Final judgment of the previous year
- In case of parity, the judgment of the teacher responsible for the exchange will be considered.

The Commission will produce a ranking of candidates based on the above-mentioned criteria and publish the **provisional ranking** which will be published on March 14, 2022 at the following links:

The ranking will be considered final when, 10 natural and consecutive days after its publication, no reviews will have been emailed to the RAEF Luana Girolami or Manuela Gonzales.

Will not be accepted reviews sent by traditional mail.

Will not be accepted reviews sent after the deadline.

For simple calculation errors (average exams - number of exams - etc.) it is not necessary to appeal; it will be sufficient to contact the RAEF (Dr. Luana Girolami and Dr. Manuela Gonzales) by going to the Erasmus office to verify the data and correct any errors, or by phone or email.

ART. 8.2 ACCEPTANCE OF MOBILITY PERIOD

The virtual meeting for the assignment of the locations will be held on **April 5th at 9:00 am**.

All the students present in the rankings are required to attend.

Please note that students who do not attend this meeting will lose the right to an assignment.

If a student is unable to attend the meeting, it is mandatory to indicate a delegate sending an email to the RAEF with a copy of an identity document of both the student and the delegate.



Selected students must accept their assigned mobility destination within 7 calendar days from the receiving date of the automatic email of assignment which will be sent to the institutional address of the student.

Candidates who do not respect this deadline will be excluded.

The definitive assignment of the Erasmus + mobility is subject to the following requirements by the student:

- Formalise the Learning Agreement to be approved by the Academic Coordinator for International Mobility (RAM) on the personal page;
- Finalise the Financial Agreement between the student and Sapienza, following the directions provided when the mobility is assigned. This step must take place **before** starting the mobility, otherwise **students would not be allowed** to benefit from the mobility and would not receive the funding, where provided, and insurance coverage.

Inclusion in the final rankings will not automatically entail the right to carry out the mobility, since the actual assignment will depend on compliance with the didactic constraints / requirements defined by each Degree Course, by the Faculty and by the assigned location.

PLEASE NOTE: **the student's mobility is subject to acceptance by the foreign Institution** which may require further certificates or reject the application on the basis of regulations that are not specified in the inter-institutional agreement signed with the partner University.

ART. 8.3 REFUSAL OF THE MOBILITY AND REPLACEMENT

The acceptance of mobility is a serious commitment for the candidate. Thus, selected candidates are expected to limit refusals, after acceptance or at the beginning of the mobility period, on account of serious and proven matters of force majeure, which must be communicated in writing and duly justified to allow replacement by the first reserve candidate in due time.

The locations remaining available after the assignment meeting in April 2022 due to lack of students with adequate language certification, will be assigned, by scrolling through the merit ranking, to students who send the language certifications required by the respective students from 15 June 2022 to 30 June 2022. offices among those indicated in Annex 1 of the Call.

At the same time, any scholarships returned will also be reassigned.

In the event of further late cancellations, the Faculty Erasmus Office will proceed with the assignment of mobility to subsequent students in the ranking who can then be contacted by email and invited to reply within 4 working days, under penalty of revocation of the mobility.

In both cases, departures will be scheduled in the second semester.

ART. 9 LEARNING AGREEMENT

All students who have accepted their assigned destination must complete an official Learning Agreement (LA) which defines the academic activities to be completed abroad. The LA guarantees the recognition of credits obtained for passed exams and thesis research work conducted abroad.

The completion and approval of the Learning Agreement are mandatory and binding to enjoy your mobility period. Failure to do so will cause your exclusion.

The L.A. must include exams or didactic activities that will ensure the recognition of **at least 6 CFUs (or no less than 3 CFUs only for thesis research)**. Students who do not meet these requirements will be forced to return the MUR funding. This limit does not concern **PhDs and Specialisation students**.



At the end of the mobility, **students must mandatorily start the procedure for the recognition** in their **career of the academic activities or research** carried out at the foreign university. The online procedure must be completed **exclusively through the Erasmus personal page**. Otherwise students shall refund the total MUR grant.

ART. 10 PROCEDURES AND LOGISTICS

In order to prepare their curricular project at the host university, students should carefully examine all available information on the university websites before applying. In fact, this information is binding for the mobility assignment.

For degree, PhD or Specialisation thesis work, students must agree on the project with their Italian Supervisor and Academic Coordinator for International Mobility, based on the agreement with the partner professor at the host university.

At the end of their courses, Erasmus students must take the planned exams following the programmes and procedures provided for students of the host university. Academic activities will be recognized as indicated by the Faculty and the “Regulation for Student Mobility and Recognition of Study Periods and Training Abroad”. Credits for exams taken at host universities must be acquired respecting all the rules and regulations of degree programme curricula.

Students must autonomously acquire information regarding housing opportunities provided by destination universities. Moreover, students are also responsible for informing themselves about:

- Health Assistance in the host country, requesting information from their local health office, diplomatic missions or at the following link <http://www.salute.gov.it>
- Entrance into the host country, timely checking for requirements with embassies and consulates (for non-EU citizens). Laws regulating the entrance of non-EU students in countries participating in the Erasmus+ Programme are based on the nationality of these students. Students are responsible for promptly obtaining information and all the documents needed to be admitted and allowed to sojourn in the destination country from the relevant diplomatic missions.

The civil liability and accident insurance coverage that students get automatically when enrolled at Sapienza is extended with the same procedures for the entire mobility period abroad at the host university <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/node/24654>

However, students are recommended to consider the opportunity of an additional insurance to cover travel and medical costs not covered by the European Health Care Card (TEAM).

It is also recommended to visit the webpage of the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs](http://www.dovesiamonelmondo.it) (www.dovesiamonelmondo.it) and register your stay abroad filling with the required data: name, city/country, host university, updated contact info and period of stay.

IN PARTICULAR FOR THE FACULTY OF PHARMACY AND MEDICINE (MEDICAL AREA) AND MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY:

1. Erasmus students are exempted from attendance at lectures and from the ADP / APP relating to courses that are held during their stay abroad; therefore the teachers concerned are required to examine them as attendance is previously validated by attendance abroad (Article 8 of the Regulations).
2. Even in the absence of a correspondence of regulations with the European Universities involved in the Erasmus Program, the student has the possibility to take exams abroad that correspond only to some parts of our integrated courses (modules), with the obligation to integrate the missing part upon returning to Sapienza and only after the online validation procedure has been completed. The teacher is therefore required to regularly carry out the missing part of the exam and finally to give an overall evaluation. In assigning the final grade, it will be necessary to mediate the grade



assigned by the teacher at the end of the test with the result of the exam that the student obtained abroad. By doing so, the teacher will be able to regularly record the entire exam on INFOSTUD. The individual modules taken abroad will be recorded out of thirty from the RAM of the student's degree course directly on the INFOSTUD. Therefore, on the day of the exam, the student must have with him the INFOSTUD certificate showing the marks of the partial exams (modules) obtained abroad to allow the teacher to proceed with the overall assessment.

3. In case of partial exams, in the drafting of the L.A. the student must indicate in the appropriate column the modules that he / she will complete abroad and the relative partial credits required by the didactic system of his / her belonging.
4. Erasmus students can take exams abroad in the years subsequent to that of enrollment, subject to compliance with the prerequisites provided for in the educational system to which they belong (eg: a student enrolled in the fourth year can take exams abroad 'didactic system of his degree course of the 5th and 6th year).
5. Erasmus students cannot take the Legal Medicine and Public Health exams abroad.
6. During his stay abroad, the student has the right to return temporarily to take exams at the Sapienza University, only and exclusively during the periods of interruption of the teaching activity established by the host sites and demonstrable through official documentation issued by the foreign branch.
7. The student can take a maximum number of exams abroad corresponding to 60 CFU / year relating to the organization they belong to, equal to 30 CFU / semester.
8. With regard to elective internships, CFUs are recognized to the extent required by the teaching system in force. It is important to bear in mind that a maximum of 2 ECTS per year can be assigned for ADE, or 1 per semester and in any case not exceeding those expressly indicated in the regulations.
9. Upon their return, Erasmus students must take the exams in their own course.
10. Students may decide not to proceed with the validation of one or more exams taken abroad, included in the official "transcript of records" document issued by the host institution. For the cancellation procedure, the student must follow the online procedure available on his personal page.
11. The mark of the internship carried out abroad can count as an exam mark only in cases where the host Faculty recognizes this modality as exclusive for all students, in the absence of normal frontal teaching activities and related formal final exam.
12. The Erasmus experience was included in the evaluation of the final degree thesis, both for the students of the single-cycle master's degree courses in Medicine and Surgery and Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics, and for the students of the three-year and master's degree courses of Healthcare Professionals.
13. Students wishing to carry out research activities for degree thesis must indicate the research topic and obtain the approval of the Italian supervisor and the indication of the foreign co-supervisor.



The credits provided for the final exam are recognized by the didactic regulations of single-cycle master's degree courses, master's degree courses of health professions and study courses of health professions as follows:

- ✓ for single-cycle Master's degree courses in Medicine and Surgery a maximum of 12 ECTS;
- ✓ for the single-cycle Master's Degree course in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics a maximum of 8 ECTS;
- ✓ for three-year study courses, a maximum of 4 ECTS;
- ✓ for two-year Master's Degree courses a maximum of 5 ECTS.

14. For students of Medicine and Surgery who benefit from an Erasmus for studies mobility grant during their 5th or 6th year, the practical training activities carried out abroad can be recognized and validated as a Practical-Evaluation Internship for the purposes of the State examination for qualification (TPVES) through the same credit transfer methods currently in force as long as the following conditions are met:

- ✓ Insertion of practical-evaluative internships within the Learning Agreement;
- ✓ Compilation of the evaluation booklet in each field by the Tutor in the host University;
- ✓ Certification of the completion and evaluation of internships in the Transcript of Records or, if this is not possible, through formal transmission of the certification to the competent Offices (International Relations, Teaching) by the relevant Offices of the host University;
- ✓ Practical activities relating to local medicine cannot be carried out abroad;

15. Students in health professions study courses can only take part of the credits related to internships abroad, given that the final exam must be taken at Sapienza. Therefore, in L.A. only a part of the credits of the internships must be reported, so that the student can book the final exam on INFOSTUD.

ART. 11 CHECKS

As per Article 71 - DPR 445 - 28/12/2000, the university administration will verify all application information through random checks on any candidature application that poses reasonable doubts on the information provided through self-certifications.

Non-compliance of information, declared or self-certified, constitutes a cause of exclusion/forfeiture.

ART. 12 PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The protection of personal data is regulated by the new European Regulation n. 679 - 27.4.2016 – GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) as well as current national legislation.

ART. 13 FINAL AUTHORITY

Under Bill N. 241 - 7.8.1990 and subsequent amendments and integrations, in the framework of the exclusive competence of Sapienza University of Rome, the final authority for this procedure are the Erasmus Administrative Officers:
